1st and 3rd person omniscient

1st person-When a character writes in the I form. when a person writes from their perspective using I, We, Us.

3rd person omniscient- when a narrator or storyteller plays no part in the story but knows all the facts and how the characters feel and think.(not to be confused with **3rd person limited** which is being told by 1 character and you only know what they think or feel.)

Purpose

the purpose of points of view is to know how certain characters feel or what they are thinking. knowing how a character is feeling or what they are thinking can make or break your understanding of a book or passage. and knowing how the character(s) is feeling can help you make a connection.

Limited and Objective

Objective- presents the action and characters speech without comment or emotion. The reader has to uncover the meaning themselves.

Limited- the material is presented in the point of view of a character in third person.
